Bank transfers can be regular as weekly, fortnightly, monthly Offerings, OR as an occasional offering

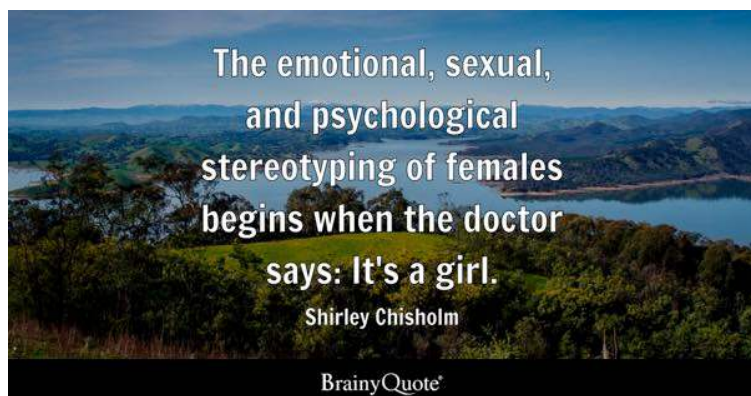
