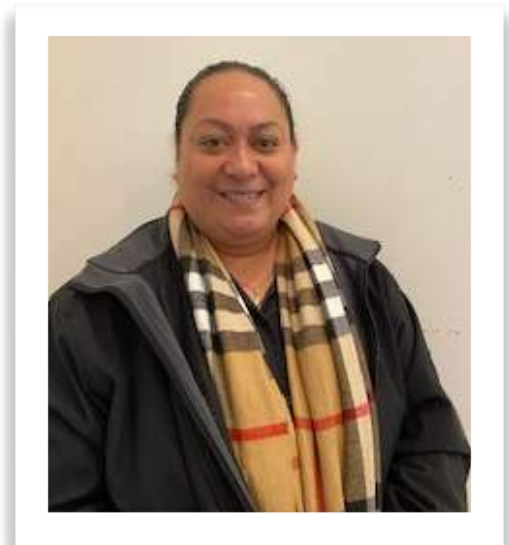

Moderator Rev David Fotheringham has joined many other faith community leaders throughout Australia in signing an open letter to the Federal Government calling on it to “urgently advocate for an immediate and permanent ceasefire in Gaza”. The letter also calls on the Government to contribute to efforts to provide aid for civilian victims of the conflict, and to “advocate for a durable and just settlement in Israel and Palestine”.
