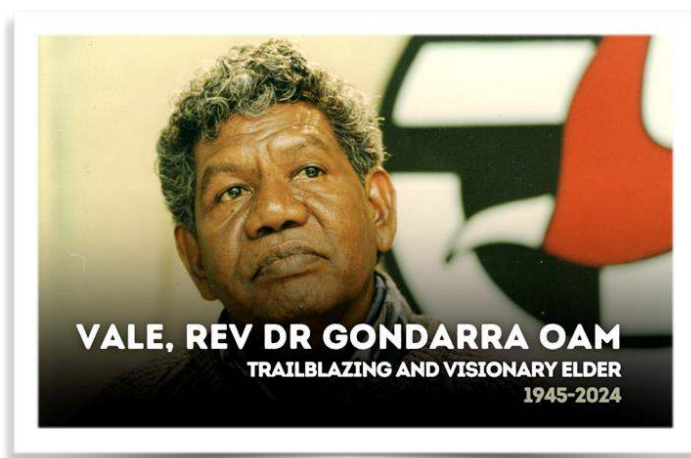

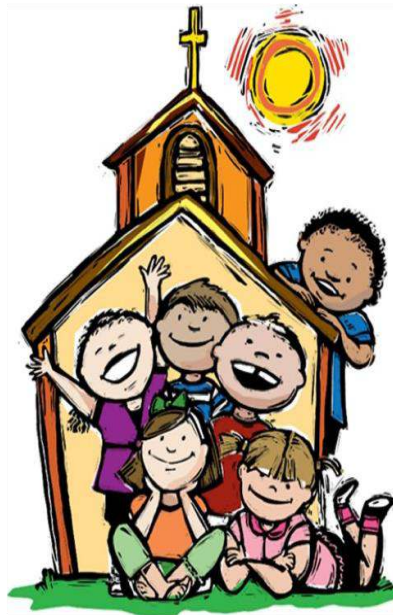

1. Air-dry your laundry

Skipping the clothes dryer benefits the climate on more than one level:

- ✓ line dry clothing: you save energy the dryer would have used.
- ✓ air drying is gentler on garments, helping them last longer: which means we buy fewer garments in a lifetime (another win for the environment!)

On Thurs 11 July, the 17th triennial Uniting Church National Assembly meeting opens in Sydney with worship and the installation of Rev Charissa Suli as the 17th President of the Uniting Church in Australia.

The installation will be an historic event, the Uniting Church being the largest Australian Christian denomination to elect a person of colour as national leader. Charissa is the youngest person to serve as UCA President and the fourth woman. The service will be live-streamed at 7.30 pm AEST (QLD, NSW, ACT, VIC, and TAS)
