At left is Ian Hill, brother of Helen Hill, who so sadly died earlier this year. Ian has just returned from Timor-Leste where he attended a ceremony sponsored by the government that involved interring some of the ashes of Helen. Ian was a guest of the government. The ceremony was held in the Santa Cruz cemetery which was the scene of a massacre in 1991 when more than 271 unarmed and peaceful protesters were shot down by Indonesian troops. Ian is holding some of the books from the library of Helen that he is donating to our lending library. The books cover a broad range of topics as befits Helen's interests. 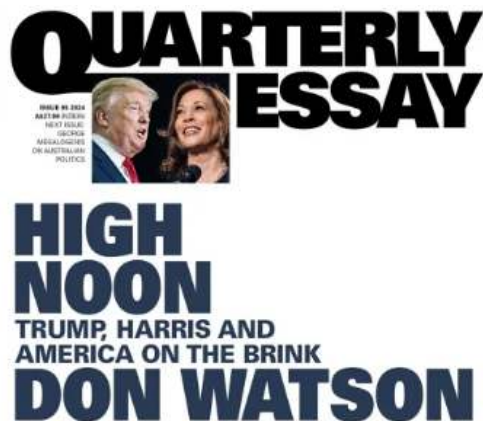

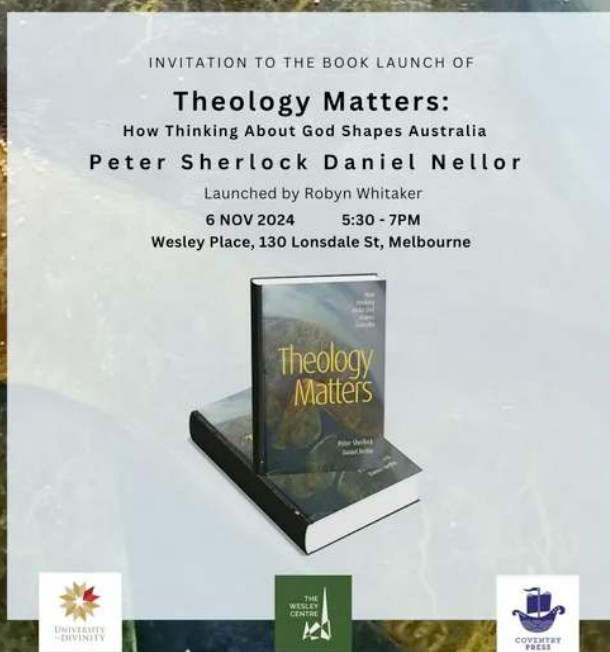
