
Studies with Mark the Evangelist

MtE's study groups seek to be ecumenical in participation, with people from MtE, Parkville's St Carthages, Carlton's Church of All Nations and Kew Uniting Church often being among those participating.

At least two online (Zoom) groups are planned on Wednesday evenings (7.45pm) and Friday afternoons (1.30PM), for seven-eight weeks (one week per chapter). These studies will commence on Wed May 14 and Friday May 16, and run for 7-8 weeks.
