"Our Homework Club kicked off again this week after a break for the school holidays. Our numbers are often affected by religious events and last term was very unpredictable due to students and their families observing Ramadan and fasting during term 1. However, term 2 has kicked off with a bang. We are delighted to have commenced our first session of the "Senior Study Group" at Carlton PS. This group has come out of concerns observed by Carlton PS and our tutors for students in grade 5 and 6

feeling adequately prepared for secondary

school.

The program will run in term 2 and 3 with a focus on coaching for completing set homework, targeting areas of academic challenge and encouraging good study skills. It is particularly well suited to our volunteer tutors from Ormond College who are young adults who understand the challenges of these significant life transitions. We were able to open this program to additional students from the grade 5 and 6 cohort at Carlton PS and the school have been enthusiastic in accommodating and supporting this additional work. The photos that came through this week showed a group of very focused volunteers and students



working together and we look forward to seeing how this new initiative evolves."

Debates are raging today about the role of religions in public life. As the world becomes increasingly interconnected, various religions come to inhabit the same space. Covering such timely issues as witness in a multifaith society and political engagement in a pluralistic world, this book highlights things Christians can do to serve the world.

MtE's study groups seek to be ecumenical in participation, with people from MtE, Parkville's St Carthages, Carlton's Church of All Nations and Kew Uniting Church often being among those participating.

At least two online (Zoom) groups are planned on Wednesday evenings (7.45pm) and Friday afternoons (1.30PM), for seveneight weeks (one week per chapter).




#### **Photos of Stations of the Cross?**
